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WHAT ARE THE DETAILS?

Today the government have published a 60 page document on how we are going to rebuild our country over the coming months.

What does this mean for our businesses? Here is a quick rundown of which businesses can re-open and when (all subject to the governments 5 tests):

1. From Wednesday 13th May

- ✓ Continue to work from home if you can
- ✓ Return to work *if your work place is open*

Workplaces currently allowed to be open include:

- ✓ Food Production
- ✓ Construction
- ✓ Manufacturing
- ✓ Logistics
- ✓ Distribution
- ✓ Scientific Research in Laboratories

All the above must follow the 'COVID-19 Secure' guidelines to making work safe asap.

The following workplaces must stay closed:

- Hospitality
- Non-Essential Retail
- Personal Care
- Leisure Facilities

2. From Monday 1st June at the earliest

As above, plus:

- ✓ Non-essential retail (where it is safe to do so!) in a phased way. More info on what will open and when will follow.

3. From Monday 6th July at the earliest

It is the ambition to open all other workplaces, these will be phased subject to trial openings.

- ✓ Hospitality (e.g. pubs and accommodation)
- ✓ Personal Care (e.g. hairdressers and beauty salons)
- ✓ Leisure Facilities (e.g. cinemas)
- ✓ Public Places (e.g. places of worship)
